- 3) Must be attending and be on track to graduate from **Lawrence High School / Haverhill High School** during the 2022 -2023 school year.
- 4) Must show of proof of being accepted into a college/university program and maintain a full-time enrollment status throughout the duration of the scholarship term.
- 5) Must provide two (2) letters of recommendation that provides information about applicant's community involvement and leadership skills.
- 6) Must be Latino or have at least one parent of Latin descent.
- 7) Possess Bilingual capacity in Spanish and English for a brief personal interview**Due to COVID-19 this interview maybe conducted by Zoom, Google or via telephone.
